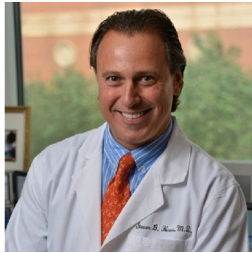

He is also a Professor of Clinical Orthopedics at Weill Cornell Medical College.

Dr. Haas speaks extensively both nationally and internationally on knee topics and has authored more than 106 publications and 25 chapters in the orthopedic literature. He has also worked on the development of knee arthroplasty techniques, software and implant design for which he has 10 US patents.
