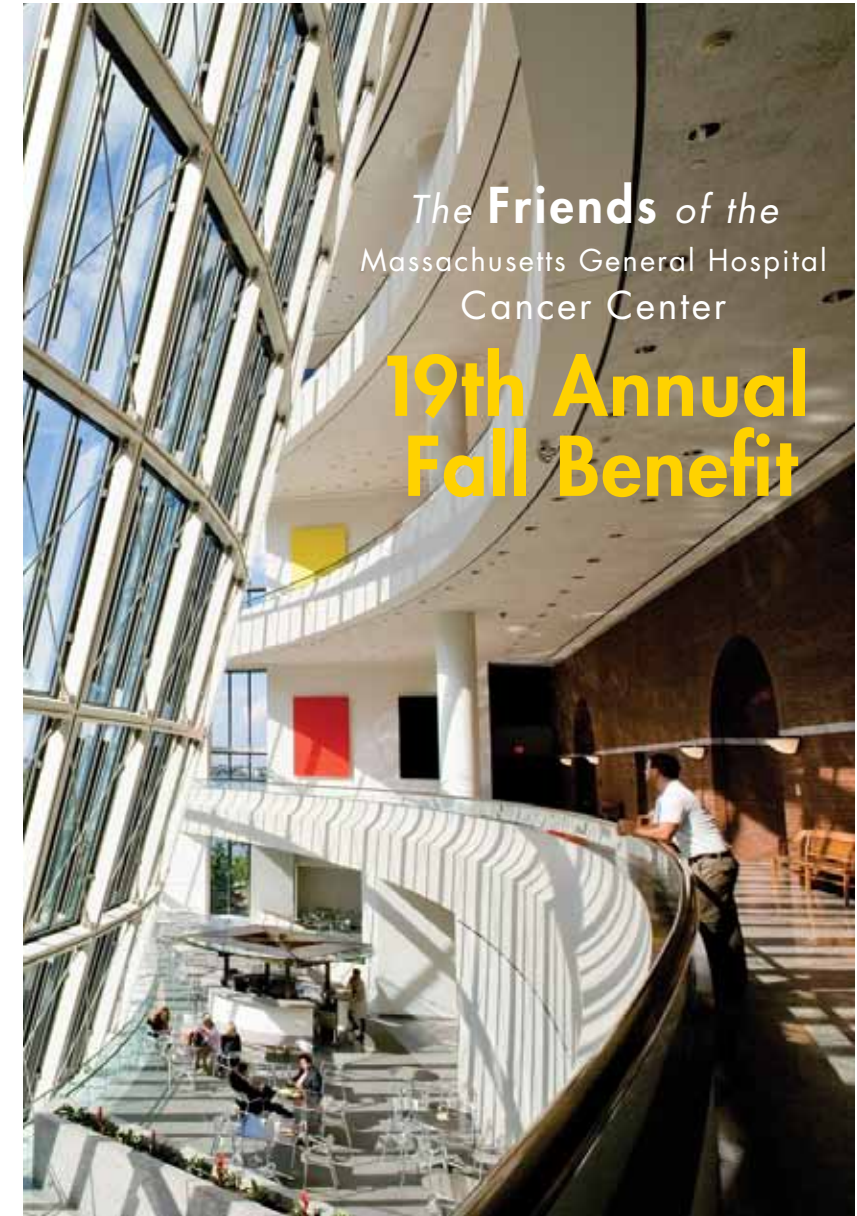

■ Driving Directions

Directions From the North

Coming over the Tobin Bridge or Southbound on Interstate 93, take the Purchase Street/South Station exit (exit 23). Once on the exit, stay in the left lane. At the first set of traffic lights, turn left onto Seaport Boulevard (sign states: So. Boston via Seaport Boulevard). Go over the Evelyn Moakley Bridge. At the first set of lights, immediately over the bridge, take a left onto Sleeper Street. The Courthouse is straight ahead. \$14 parking is available across from the Courthouse.

Directions From the South

From Interstate 93 Northbound, stay to your right and take Exit 20 toward Logan Airport/South Boston. After the first exit on the off ramp (South Station), stay to the left. Take the Logan Airport/South Boston exit on the off ramp. Enter the tunnel staying to the right. Taking the South Boston exit (first exit in the tunnel). Stay straight toward Seaport Boulevard. Go straight through two (2) sets of traffic lights and follow around the curve to the left. The Courthouse is the last building on the right before the bridge into downtown Boston. \$14 parking is available across from the Courthouse.

Directions From the West

Follow Mass Pike East/Interstate 90 and take the Logan Airport/South Boston extension. Stay to the right and take the first exit (exit 25) for South Boston. Bear left off the ramp toward Seaport Boulevard. Go straight through two (2) sets of traffic lights and follow around the curve to the left. The Courthouse is the last building on the right before the bridge into downtown Boston. \$14 parking is available across from the Courthouse.

Directions From Storrow Drive

Take Storrow Drive East to Leverett Circle and follow signs for Interstate 93 South/Logan Airport. Once on Interstate 93 South, take the Purchase Street/South Station exit (exit 23). Once on the exit, stay in the left lane. At the first set of traffic lights, turn left onto Seaport Boulevard (sign states: So. Boston via Seaport Boulevard). Go over the Evelyn Moakley Bridge. At the first set of lights, immediately over the bridge, take a left onto Sleeper Street. The Courthouse is straight ahead. \$14 parking is available across from the Courthouse.

Directions From Ted Williams Tunnel (Logan Airport)

From Logan Airport, follow Interstate 90 Westbound/Ted Williams Tunnel to exit 25-24 toward South Boston. After exiting the tunnel, stay right onto B Street. Turn left at first set of traffic lights onto Seaport Boulevard/Northern Avenue. The Courthouse is the last building on the right before the bridge into downtown Boston. \$14 parking is available across from the Courthouse.

■ Directions By Public Transportation

From Downtown Crossing and South Station

The number 7 bus stops in the Downtown Crossing area at Summer and Otis Streets at South Station. From South Station, take the Silver Line. The first stop is the Courthouse.

From North Station

The number 4 bus runs from North Station on Sleeper Street between Old Northern Avenue and Seaport Boulevard, one block from the Courthouse, 7 am to 9 am and 4 pm to 6 pm only.

Express Buses from the North Shore

Express buses run from the North Shore to the Fan Pier area. The numbers 448, 449, and 459 travel from Marblehead, Salem and Revere and stop at Sleeper and Congress Streets (Children's Museum stop), which is just one block from the Courthouse.

MBTA Water Shuttle from the South Shore

The water shuttle from Hingham stops at Rowes Wharf/Boston Harbor Hotel, a short walk from the Courthouse (which can be seen across the harbor from Rowes Wharf). For further information, visit the MBTA website at www.mbta.com.

■ Walking Information

From South Station (Red Line and Commuter Rail)

Go north on Atlantic Avenue (South Station exit is on the corner of Atlantic Avenue and Summer Street) – cross Summer and Congress Streets. Take a right across either Old Northern Avenue Bridge or the Evelyn Moakley Bridge to the Courthouse. Walking Time: Approx. 11 minutes.

From State Street (Orange & Blue Lines)

Devonshire Street exit from the station. East on Devonshire for one (1) block. Left onto Water Street. Cross Congress Street. After one (1) short block, take first right onto Oliver Street (no sign). Follow Oliver Street three (3) blocks, then left onto High Street. Take pedestrian walkway from High Street, across Purchase Street, to Atlantic Avenue. Right on Atlantic Avenue for one (1) block, then cross the Old Northern Avenue Bridge to the Courthouse. Walking Time: Approx. 13 minutes.

From Aquarium (Blue Line)

Follow signs for Aquarium. Cross over Atlantic Avenue and take a right. Walk about ¼ mile along Atlantic Avenue and take a left onto the Old Northern Avenue Bridge to the Courthouse. Walk Time: Approx. 7 minutes.

From North Station (Orange & Green Lines and Commuter Rail)

Walk across Causeway Street and down Canal Street or Portland Street (2 blocks). Facing New Chardon Street and the Government Center Garage, go right to the intersection of New Chardon Street and Congress Street and take Congress Street under the garage. Continue for six (6) blocks, then left onto Water Street. After one (1) short block, take first right on Oliver Street (no sign). Follow Oliver Street for three (3) blocks, then left onto High Street. Take pedestrian walkway from High Street, across Purchase Street, to Atlantic Avenue. Right on Atlantic Avenue for one (1) block, then cross the Old Northern Avenue Bridge to the Courthouse. Walking Time: Approx. 22 minutes.
