



GUIDELINES FOR ARTWORK IN THE HOSPITAL ENVIRONMENT

The *Illuminations* exhibit is on display throughout the Cancer Center and is intended to shed light on the human experience, contribute healing qualities to the hospital environment, and offer patients a visual reference point for reflection as they are waiting for treatment.

In selecting artwork for the exhibition, the *Illuminations* Committee considers these goals as well as the needs of our patients. We ask contributors to keep in mind that the audience for these exhibits will include patients with cancer and their families, who will be sensitive to the mood and subject conveyed by the painting, sculpture, or photograph. Harsh, potentially disturbing, or confusing images, despite their artistic value, will likely not be accepted for display.

As you select the artwork you will submit for review, it may be helpful for you to consider your work from these perspectives.
