All programs are free and open to MGH staff, patients, and the general public. Spaces are limited. No registration needed.

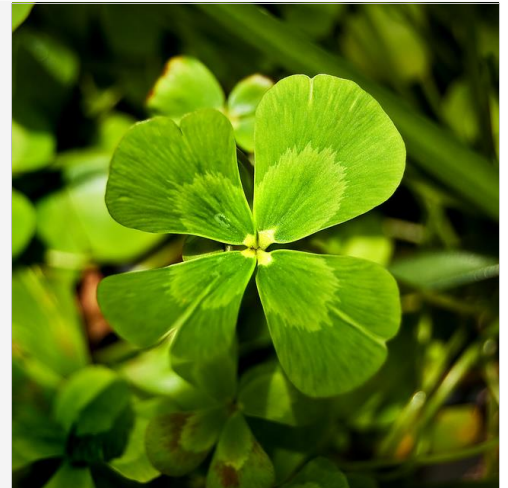
## Understanding Lymphedema Thursday, March 22, 12:00PM - 1:00PM
