**Caio Nery, MD, PhD** earned both his MD in 1979 and his PhD in Orthopaedics in 1985 from the Federal University of São Paulo, Brazil. In 1994, Dr. Nery was appointed full professor and served as president of the Brazilian Foot and Ankle Society. On the international stage, he chaired the Latin American Foot and Ankle Society, and was also a member of the International Federation of Foot & Ankle Societies (IFFAS) Board of Directors. Over the course of 35 years and training more than 80 specialists, Dr. Nery created the premier Foot and Ankle Fellowship in Brazil. He is recognized as an international expert on foot & ankle pathology and has published over 80 peer-viewed publications in various topics ranging from total ankle replacement, forefoot pathology, ankle instability and tendinopathies.
