Screening of Research Subjects is a feature available for Patients and Support Persons.

## Research Subject Screening Workflows

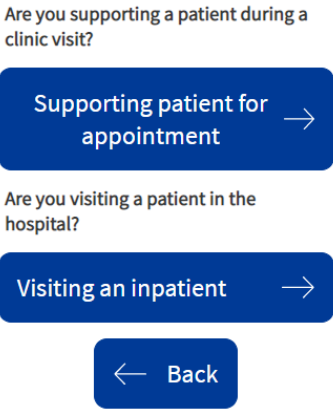
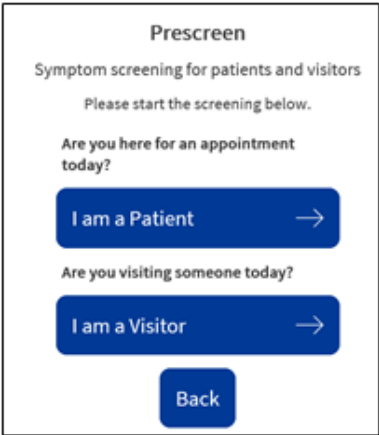
- Research Subject arrives at facility/clinic
- Support Person arrives with Research Subject
  1. Support Person has been pre-approved to accompany Research Subject

## Research Subject Screening with MGB Prescreen

1. Visitor can hover phone camera over the QR code on the posted signs or opens internet browser and types in the following URL: <https://prescreen.massgeneralbrigham.org>
2. Visitor taken to the following introductive screen, asking for preferred language:



3. Research Subject identifies as Patient or Visitor
4. Visitors accompanying Research Subjects should choose Supporting patient for appointment



5. Support Person chooses location (parent hospital if visiting clinic/practice):

7. Research Subject and Support Person completes risk factor screening. Unique to Support Persons, they will be asked a question as to whether they are a pre-approved Support Person. If they answer No, they will be prompted with a message to contact the practice and obtain approval before completing Prescreen:

\*In the last 14 days, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19?

\*In the last 14 days, have you had close contact with someone with COVID-19?

Note that "close contact" is defined as spending ≥15 minutes within 6 feet of someone currently infected with COVID-19. Healthcare workers wearing appropriate PPE while caring for COVID-19 patients are not considered exposed.

Research Subject Pass Logic Breakdown

The type of pass a visitor receives will be dependent on how they respond the risk/symptoms questions:
