Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) is one of the most common disorders of childhood. All kids struggle to pay attention, listen, manage their impulses, and follow directions. However, for children with ADHD, the struggles are harder and the behaviors happen more frequently. In this presentation, Dr. Ellen Braaten will discuss the symptoms of ADHD, how it is assessed, and the pros and cons of the most effective treatment options.



Featured Speaker: Ellen Braaten, PhD

Dr. Braaten is the Executive Director of the Learning and Emotional Assessment Program (LEAP) at Mass General, and an Associate Professor of Psychology at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Braaten is widely recognized as an expert in assessing learning disabilities and attentional disorders. She is the co-author of many books and articles for parents and professionals including the books *Bright Kids Who Can't Keep Up* (2014) and *Bright Kids Who Couldn't Care Less: How to Rekindle Your Child's Motivation* (2023).
