Are you living with atopic dermatitis?

If you have moderate to severe atopic dermatitis, also known as eczema, talk to your doctor about participating in a clinical research study of a potential treatment for the disease.



The purpose of this research study is to evaluate the safety and effectiveness of an investigational medication, in tablet form, or placebo for atopic dermatitis, also known as eczema.

You may qualify for participation if you:

- Are age 12 years and older and weigh at least 88 lbs (40 kg),
- Have moderate to severe atopic dermatitis and have experienced symptoms for 1 year or more,
- Have had an inadequate response to treatment with topical medication or have required systemic therapies, and
- Are willing to follow a plan of scheduled study visits, lab tests and other study procedures for the duration of the study, up to 20 weeks.

If you cannot avoid prolonged sun exposure and/or avoid the use of tanning booths or exposure to other ultraviolet light sources during the study period, you may not be eligible for this study.

For eligible study participants, all investigational medication (or placebo), study-related tests and study doctor's visits will be provided at no cost to you for the duration of the study, up to 20 weeks. Participation is voluntary and you may withdraw at any time.
