Overview:

The MGH Center for Faculty Development and the MESH Incubator are pleased to announce the launch of our new mentoring and research collaboration website, MentorMGB (www.mentorMGB.org). This platform is available to faculty, postdocs, graduate students, and others across MGH, BWH, and affiliated hospitals to encourage cross-specialty mentorship and research collaboration. Through this, we hope to foster a dynamic cross-institution mentorship culture and facilitate research collaborations.

This mentorship platform can be thought of as "LinkedIn" for the MGB community, connecting faculty across hospitals for finding and giving secondary mentorship, collaborating on research interests/finding new projects, and general work and non-work discussion/connections.

Faculty, Postdocs, Graduate Students, and others can join by registering on the MentorMGB platform with their partners.org and harvard.edu email and create a profile.


If you already have a login, you can login directly here: https://www.mentormgb.org

Go to your profile (top right-hand corner) and click edit profile from the dropdown to make changes to your profile page.








Brief description of features:


