

Narrative

You need not reiterate your history of training, but the chronology of your accomplishments should be clear. You should make clear the extent of your reputation and the key achievements for which you are known. If your accomplishments bridge different arenas (e.g. research and clinical care), you may wish to clarify any connections that are not readily apparent.

The narrative should be written in the first person and should be concise. In general, length should be commensurate with rank. Most narratives for Instructor and Assistant Professor candidates should be ≤1 page; no narrative should exceed two pages.

-Your contributions in your Area of Excellence (Investigation, Teaching, Educational Leadership, or Clinical Expertise and Innovation). You may want to include a description of work in progress that may otherwise not be reflected in your CV.
-Your contributions in teaching (if not already described under your Area of Excellence).
-Your contributions in any Significant Supporting Activities (Investigation, Clinical Expertise, Special Merit in Education, Administration & Institutional Service, Education of Patients and Service to the Community)

My professional activities are focused on improving patient safety, developing workflows for patient care that are safer, faster and easier for clinicians and operational excellence within perioperative systems. My activities are divided between (1) Clinical Experience; (2) Clinical Leadership; (3) Hospital Leadership and (4) Clinical Innovation through leadership and novel patient safety tools. My work has been recognized locally, nationally and internationally. Through this work, I have established an international reputation as a leader in perioperative systems, patient safety and leadership.

I have 17 published book chapters with the 18th in press and have served as both an associate editor and senior editor of the most popular clinical anesthesia handbook in the world – Clinical Anesthesia Procedures of the Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH). In addition, I have 14 peer reviewed publications and 13 United States and International Patents (12 granted and one pending). I have numerous other publications in newsletters, abstracts and educational materials. I am often an invited lecturer to discuss patient safety, medical technology, operating room management and leadership locally, regionally and internationally. Internationally, I am the faculty director for the Harvard Medical School / China Visiting Professors Program.

All of the work described below is all done while providing clinical care in our operating rooms, covering hospital capacity needs, and managing whatever is needed, anytime and anyplace. If there is a question, it is my job to find a solution and to make your work easier.

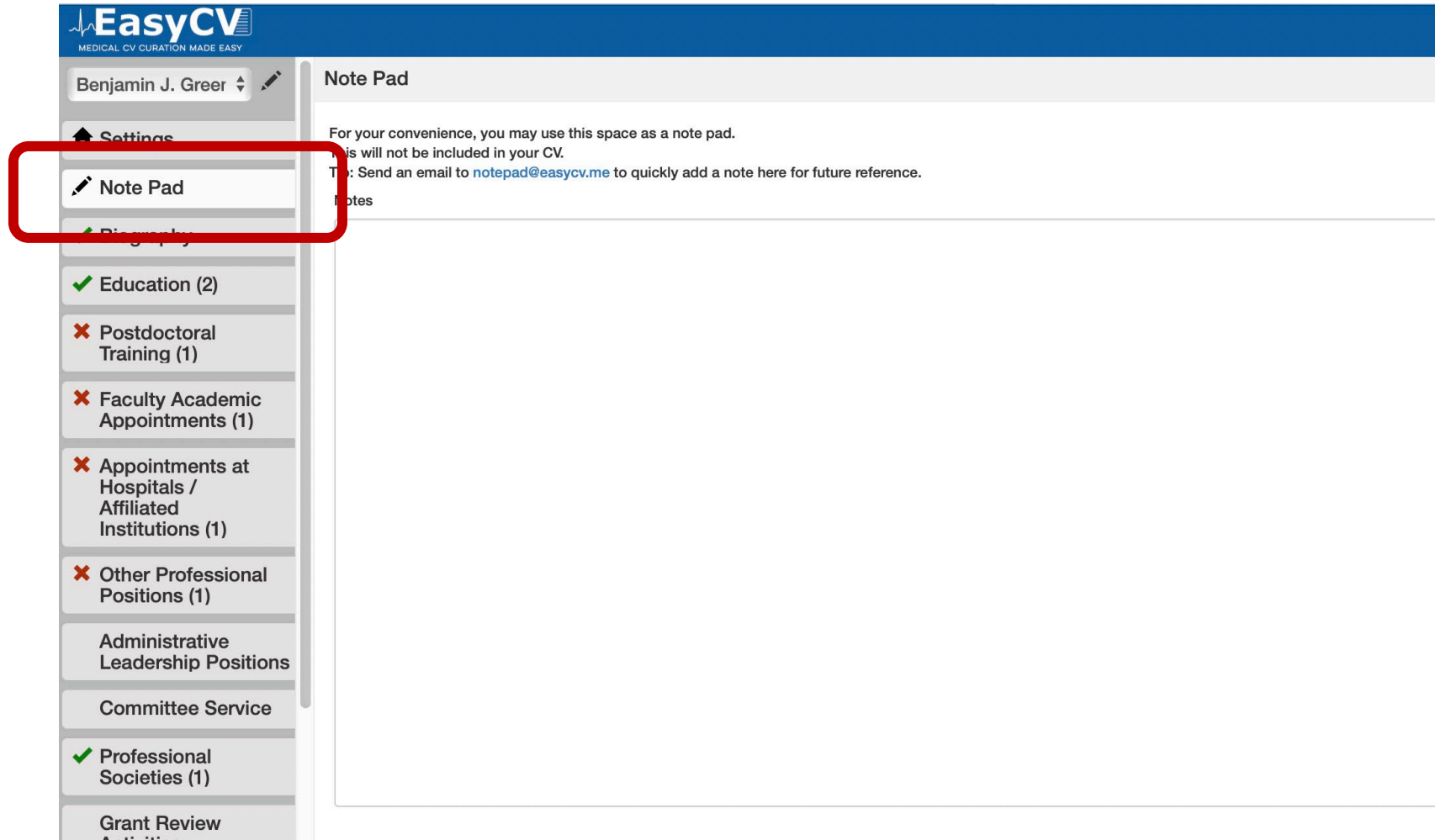
Clinical Expertise
