- 220 active patients (80-100 new annually)
- 4 clinicians, 3 RNs



Perpetual Adaptive Trial Shared Placebo; Randomization Ratio 3:1 Open Label Extension (OLE) offered



Enrollment Updates (as of October 21, 2021)

- 815 individuals with ALS signed informed consent
- 646 individuals were assigned to a regimen
- 584 individuals were randomized within a regimen (active or placebo)
- 239 have entered the Open Label Extension (OLE)
- 158 individuals were randomized within Regimen A
- 167 individuals were randomized within Regimen B
- 161 individuals were randomized within Regimen C
- 98 individuals were randomized within Regimen D
