Sampling of most common procedures performed by Fellows

<b>27650</b>	Repair, primary, open or percutaneous, ruptured Achilles tendon;
<b>27658</b>	Repair, flexor tendon, leg; primary, without graft, each tendon
<b>27665</b>	Repair, extensor tendon, leg; secondary, with or without graft, each tendon
<b>27675</b>	Repair, dislocating peroneal tendons; without fibular osteotomy
<b>27676</b>	Repair, dislocating peroneal tendons; with fibular osteotomy
<b>27685</b>	Lengthening or shortening of tendon, leg or ankle; single tendon (separate procedure)
<b>27687</b>	Gastrocnemius recession (eg, Strayer procedure)
<b>27690</b>	Transfer or transplant of single tendon (with muscle redirection or rerouting); superficial (eg, anterior tibial extensors into midfoot)
<b>27691</b>	Transfer or transplant of single tendon (with muscle redirection or rerouting); deep (eg, anterior tibial or posterior tibial through interosseous space, flexor digitorum longus, flexor hallucis longus, or peroneal tendon to midfoot or hindfoot)
<b>27698</b>	Repair, secondary, disrupted ligament, ankle, collateral (eg, Watson-Jones procedure)
<b>27702</b>	Arthroplasty, ankle; with implant (total ankle)
<b>27703</b>	Arthroplasty, ankle; revision, total ankle
<b>27792</b>	Open treatment of distal fibular fracture (lateral malleolus), includes internal fixation, when performed
<b>27814</b>	Open treatment of bimalleolar ankle fracture (eg, lateral and medial malleoli, or lateral and posterior malleoli, or medial and posterior malleoli), includes internal fixation, when performed
<b>27823</b>	Open treatment of trimalleolar ankle fracture, includes internal fixation, when performed, medial and/or lateral malleolus; with fixation of posterior lip
<b>27825</b>	Closed treatment of fracture of weight bearing articular portion of distal tibia (eg, pilon or tibial plafond), with or without anesthesia; with skeletal traction and/or requiring manipulation
<b>27826</b>	Open treatment of fracture of weight bearing articular surface/portion of distal tibia (eg, pilon or tibial plafond), with internal fixation, when performed; of fibula only
<b>27827</b>	Open treatment of fracture of weight bearing articular surface/portion of distal tibia (eg, pilon or tibial plafond), with internal fixation, when performed; of tibia only
<b>27828</b>	Open treatment of fracture of weight bearing articular surface/portion of distal tibia (eg, pilon or tibial plafond), with internal fixation, when performed; of both tibia and fibula
<b>27870</b>	Arthrodesis, ankle, open
<b>27880</b>	Amputation, leg, through tibia and fibula;
<b>27888</b>	Amputation, ankle, through malleoli of tibia and fibula (eg, Syme, Pirogoff type procedures), with plastic closure and resection of nerves
<b>28116</b>	Ostectomy, excision of tarsal coalition
<b>28120</b>	Partial excision (craterization, saucerization, sequestrectomy, or diaphysectomy) bone (eg, osteomyelitis or bossing); talus or calcaneus
<b>28285</b>	Correction, hammertoe (eg, interphalangeal fusion, partial or total phalangectomy)
<b>28296</b>	Correction, hallux valgus (bunion), with or without sesamoidectomy; with metatarsal osteotomy (eg, Mitchell, Chevron, or concentric type procedures)

28297	Correction, hallux valgus (bunion), with or without sesamoidectomy; Lapidus-type procedure
28299	Correction, hallux valgus (bunion), with or without sesamoidectomy; by double osteotomy
28300	Osteotomy; calcaneus (eg, Dwyer or Chambers type procedure), with or without internal fixation
28304	Osteotomy, tarsal bones, other than calcaneus or talus;
28306	Osteotomy, with or without lengthening, shortening or angular correction, metatarsal; first metatarsal
28308	Osteotomy, with or without lengthening, shortening or angular correction, metatarsal; other than first metatarsal, each
28415	Open treatment of calcaneal fracture, includes internal fixation, when performed
28445	Open treatment of talus fracture, includes internal fixation, when performed
28615	Open treatment of tarsometatarsal joint dislocation, includes internal fixation, when performed
28715	Arthrodesis; triple
28725	Arthrodesis; subtalar
28730	Arthrodesis, midtarsal or tarsometatarsal, multiple or transverse;
28740	Arthrodesis, midtarsal or tarsometatarsal, single joint
28800	Amputation, foot; midtarsal (eg, Chopart type procedure)
28805	Amputation, foot; transmetatarsal
28810	Amputation, metatarsal, with toe, single
29897	Arthroscopy, ankle (tibiotalar and fibulotalar joints), surgical; debridement, limited
29898	Arthroscopy, ankle (tibiotalar and fibulotalar joints), surgical; debridement, extensive
29899	Arthroscopy, ankle (tibiotalar and fibulotalar joints), surgical; with ankle arthrodesis
