Admission Process and Program Costs

Eligibility Requirements

- Graduate of a CAPTE accredited PT program or the equivalent (as evidenced by eligibility for state PT licensure)
- Currently licensed in the state of Massachusetts or license-eligible in Massachusetts by the start of the residency year
- Meets all eligibility requirements to be employed as a practicing physical therapist within MGH PT Services
- Completed a minimum of 10 weeks of clinical experience in a neurologic setting either as PT student or as a licensed PT

Application Process

Submit application through RF-PTCAS (https://rfptcas.liaisoncas.com/applicant-ux/#/login) including:

- For those with less than 5 years of clinical practice: an official transcript from each PT college and university attended
- Curriculum Vitae
- Answers to the following questions:
 - Why are you applying for a neurologic residency at this point in your career?
 - What specific characteristics do you possess that make you an ideal candidate for this residency program?
 - Where do you hope a neurologic residency will take you in your career development over the next three to five years?
- Three letters of recommendation at least one of which must be clinical

Select candidates will then have an interview onsite or via video call.
