Health Insurance Navigation for Cancer Survivors

Dr. Elyse Park will present her work on the impact of cancer on long-term cancer survivors' financial burden. She will describe the intervention that she developed, health insurance navigation tools (HINT), and its impact on improving health insurance literacy and financial burden. She will also show research designs that illustrate how this navigation program is being delivered virtually and assessed nationally.



Featured Speaker: Elyse R. Park, PhD, MPH, FAPOS

Dr. Park is the Director of the Health Promotion and Resiliency Research Center and Associate Director of Survivorship Research and Psychosocial Services for the Mass General Cancer Center Survivorship Program. She is a clinical health psychologist and health services researcher who focuses on improving health-related behaviors among cancer survivors and patients at risk for cancer. Dr. Park has published extensively on financial burden and healthcare utilization among survivors. She has received ACS and NCI funding to conduct trials assessing the impact of virtual patient navigation interventions in improving health literacy, financial burden, and healthcare utilization.
