Rabbi Shulamit Izen, MAHL, BCC (She/Her)

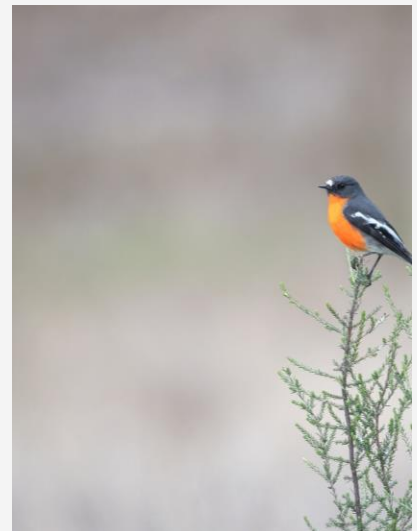
Shulamit Izen is a ACPE Certified Educator at the Massachusetts General Hospital. Her joy is helping students come in contact with their most authentic selves.
