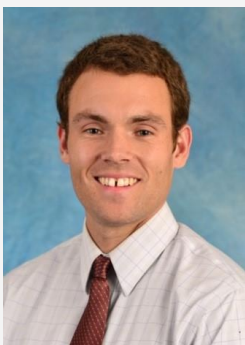
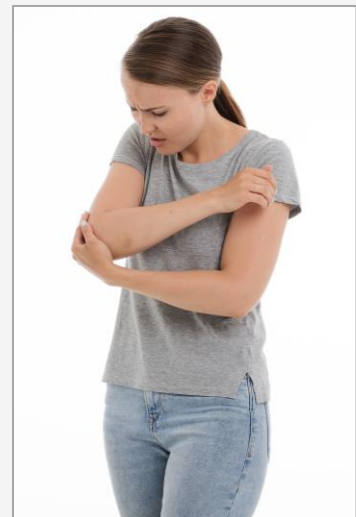
# Bursitis and Tendinitis: Common Non-Arthritic Causes of Musculoskeletal Pain
