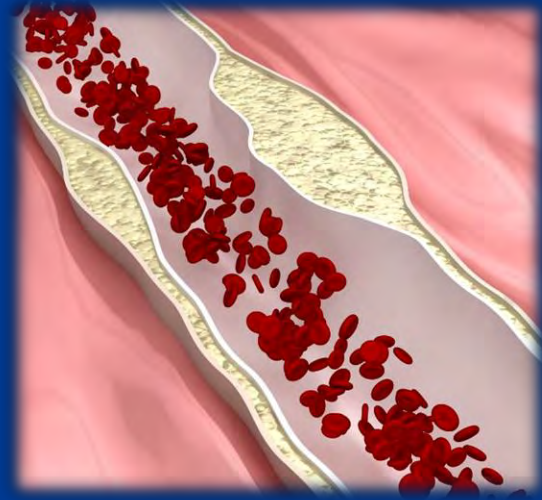


High Cholesterol
