Where is it?

Internships will be held in person at MGH unless the evolving COVID-19 pandemic prevents on site activities. In that case, internships will be held virtually. **All interns must comply with MGH's occupational health requirements including the COVID-19 vaccination policy.**

Am I eligible?

We are looking for students who are:

- (1) Interested in learning more about neurology and neurology-related careers
- (2) Available to participate in a FULL-TIME, PAID internship over the summer
- (3) Rising seniors in high school or recent high school graduates/rising college freshman to join our **high school student cohort**, and undergraduate students who have completed at least 1 year of their studies by the time the program starts (including 2023 college graduates) to join our **undergraduate student cohort**
- (4) Living or studying in Massachusetts (must be residing in MA throughout the duration of the program)
