Rohit Garg, MBBS joined the hand & upper extremity service at the Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) in April 2019. He graduated from the prestigious All India Institute of Medical Sciences, followed by an orthopedic surgery residency training at the University of Illinois, Chicago, and then a hand & upper extremity fellowship at the MGH.

After his initial training, Dr. Garg embarked on additional learning fellowships overseas. In Canada, he worked with Dr. Graham King to enhance his experience in total elbow replacement, elbow contracture release and elbow trauma. Then he went to Ganga Hospital in Coimbatore, India where he obtained further valuable experience in microsurgery, adult and pediatric brachial plexus surgeries, complex reconstruction of the upper extremity, nerve injuries and reconstruction, pediatric hand, and free tissue transfer. Following that, Dr. Garg worked with Dr. Somsak Leechavengvongs in Thailand where he gained further expertise in adult and pediatric brachial plexus injuries, with a special focus on shoulder reconstruction and intercostal nerve transfers.

Dr. Garg’s interests include hand, elbow and upper extremity fractures, nerve injuries and reconstruction, brachial plexus injuries, complex reconstructive surgery of the upper extremity, and pediatric hand.
