- Permitted work hours are Monday through Friday, 12 am to 12 am, and Saturday to Sunday from 12 am to 12 pm.
- Permitted work hours for Cambridge Street utilities are Monday through Friday, 7 pm to 3 am, and Saturday through Sunday, 7 am to 3 pm.
- Permitted work hours for Blossom Street utilities are Monday through Friday, 9:30 am to 3:30 pm, and Saturday through Sunday, 7 am to 3 pm.
- Permitted work hours for Parkman Street utilities are Saturday and Sunday, 7 am to 3 pm.
- Permitted equipment and material deliveries may come to and from the site outside of normal construction working hours.
- Advance notice will be given prior to weekend and off-hours work.

Roadway and Sidewalk Impairment

- There will be intermittent daily interruptions to the sidewalk and vehicle travel lane adjacent to the construction site to facilitate utility work as it becomes available through the permitting process.
- Parkman Street will be closed beginning 8 p.m. on Friday till 6 p.m. Saturday for Temporary Bridge construction.
 - The Parkman Street Garage will remain open with access to Fruit Street and North Grove Street only.
 - o There will be no access to Blossom Street or the Wang Loop via Parkman Street.
- The north driving lane on Parkman Street will be closed during the temporary bridge steel erection on weekdays from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

Utility Work

- Eversource and Riley Brothers will be excavating and installing underground electric services on Blossom Street Saturdays and Sundays. This work will cause intermittent impairments in the pedestrian walkway and vehicle travel lanes on Blossom Street.
- National Grid will be working on Cambridge Street and Blossom Street on weekends from 7 am to 7 pm.
- National Grid will be working on weekdays from 7 pm to 5 am and weekends from 7 am to 3 pm.

Work with the Potential for Noise, Vibration and Odor Impacts

- Trucks to import and export soil and material in and out of the job site
- Heavy construction equipment
- Excavation and obstruction removal
- Concrete chipping and sawcutting
- Excavation within the site may cause odors around campus. Odors are being monitored and mitigated on an as-needed basis.
- Waterproofing within the site may cause odors around campus.
