
# Delayed Tolerance Program Roadmap



## **After Transplant**

After your transplant, you'll work with the transplant team to create an action plan for your ongoing care.



#### Conditioning

The recipient is admitted 1 week before transplant to start medication and thymus irradiation to prepare for transplantation.



### **Transplant**

An infusion of donor bone marrow or blood stem cells is given to induce transplant tolerance.



#### **Tapering**

Following a normal biopsy, gradual reduction of immunosuppressive medication begins and is completed 1 year after transplantation.



#### **Monitoring**

Biopsy of the transplanted kidney and blood tests performed 6 months posttransplant to monitor for rejection.



#### **Maintenance**

The recipient is on immunosuppressants to prevent rejection of the transplanted kidney.
